ICPS PARIS CONFERENCE 18 MARCH 2023



The ICPS Paris conference (18 March 23), entitled “*Transition to a future Iran: A realistic look at what is required*”, represents an effort by a group of reformist forces (“*Tahavolkhan*”) and advocates of change to discuss and think about realistic solutions for a practical and all-encompassing path that is needed for transitioning away from the Islamic Republic and the “Deep State”.

It follows that in achieving the desired goal of transitioning to a new democratic order based on the will of the Iranian people, it is crucial that all measures and solutions are examined in a responsible manner to make sure that not only do they safeguard the security of the citizens' lives from undue chaos and unrest, but also ensure that the territorial integrity of the country should stay intact.
